Health Partners International of Canada (HPIC) is a not-for-profit relief and development organization dedicated to increasing access to medicine and improving health in the developing world, with a special focus on women and children. The organization responds to emergencies and health threats and works with in-country partners to develop local capacities. Together with partners around the globe, HPIC has distributed more than \$375 million in medicines and medical supplies for people in more than 110 countries.

The health of a community is key to sustainable development and enables people to fully participate in their family and society. Access to medicine is often challenging in developing countries, and millions of people die from preventable and treatable diseases. Receiving medical treatment enables a mother to care for her children, a parent to work and provide for the family, and a child to go to school.

HPIC is supported by donations from the Canadian public, pharmaceutical and healthcare product companies, and the Canadian government. In development projects HPIC works with local governments to build their capacities to provide healthcare services by improving distribution processes, enhancing medical facilities and equipment, and supporting the training of local professionals in pharmaceutical management.

Programs:

Capacity Building

HPIC partners with local governments to build capacity in the area of pharmaceutical management.

Community Development

HPIC collaborates with NGOs and medical professionals, in the context of sustainable community health projects, to provide medicines and medical supplies to people who would otherwise go without.

Emergency Relief

HPIC works with the World Health Organization, international ministries of health, partner NGOs, the Canadian pharmaceutical and healthcare products companies and the medical community to respond to emergencies in the developing world.

Physician Travel Pack / Dental Travel Pack

HPIC provides specialized medical kits for healthcare professionals on medical missions in impoverished communities overseas. Each Physician Travel Pack (PTP) contains an assortment of essential medicines and medical supplies that is designed to provide up to 600 treatments.
