Health Partners International of Canada is a not-for-profit relief and development organization that works through partnerships, without discrimination and according to Christian values, to increase access to medicine and improve health in the developing world.

How we work

HPIC partners with physicians, NGOs and government agencies working in developing countries to deliver a variety of vital healthcare services. HPIC and our partners serve at-risk communities and vulnerable individuals, including women, orphans, the elderly, and those living with HIV/AIDS. Canadian healthcare companies donate in-date medicines, vaccines and medical supplies that meet identified needs.

Emergency Relief

HPIC works with the WHO, international ministries of health, the Canadian healthcare industry and medical community, and partner NGOs to respond to emergencies in the developing world.

Capacity Building

HPIC partners with governments and agencies to help countries and communities help themselves. HPIC completed a five-year development program in Cuba that included improvements to infrastructure and increased the capacity of healthcare services. HPIC is beginning a multi-year program in Afghanistan.

Community Development

HPIC collaborates with aid agencies and medical professionals to provide medicines and medical supplies to people who would otherwise go without, in the context of sustainable community health projects.

Physician Travel Pack / Dental Travel Pack

HPIC provides travel packs to Canadian healthcare professionals who volunteer in impoverished communities overseas. The Physician Travel Pack (PTP) consists of two hand-carried boxes containing an assortment of essential medicines and medical supplies that can treat hundreds of people. The Dental Travel Pack (DTP) includes antibiotics, anesthetics, supplies and dental materials.

Funding

HPIC is a registered charity. Funding comes from sources such as the Canadian government, the healthcare industry, foundations, agency partners and individuals.

Every \$1 donated to HPIC provides at least \$10 of medical aid.
